Qualification structure and how to achieve

To be awarded the **Level 1 or Level 2 Technical Award in Interactive Media**, learners are required to successfully complete 4 mandatory units for each qualification. Learners must also achieve a minimum of a Pass in the external assessment.

Unit 1 - Investigate interactive media production	Internally assessed and externally assessed
Unit 2 - Plan and prepare for an interactive media product	Internally assessed and externally assessed
Unit 3 - Development and production of an interactive media product	Internally assessed and externally assessed
Unit 4 - Present and promote an interactive media product	Internally assessed and externally assessed
