## About these qualifications

V Certs are a suite of high quality technical qualifications which are appropriate for Key Stage 4 learners. They are a technical alternative to GCSEs with equivalent levels of rigour and challenge.

The Level 1 and Level 2 Technical Awards in Interactive Media are designed to provide learners with the skills, knowledge and understanding of digital media including combinations of electronic text, graphics, moving images and sound in a structured digital computerised environment.

Throughout the qualifications, learners will gain valuable knowledge of:

- how to identify and experiment with interactive media products, materials, techniques and processes
- the interactive media industry and associated job roles
- working to interactive media briefs, refining, developing and selecting ideas
- forming an interactive media portfolio

## Qualification structure

To be awarded the Level 1 or Level 2 Technical Award in Interactive Media, learners are required to successfully complete four mandatory units for each qualification. Learners must also achieve a minimum of a Pass in the external assessment.

### Mandatory units

Unit 01: Investigate interactive media production
Unit 02: Plan and prepare for an interactive media product
Unit 03: Development and production of an interactive media product
Unit 04: Present and promote an interactive media product

## Assessment

All 4 units comprise internal and external assessment.

## **Progression opportunities**

Learners who achieve the Level 2 Technical Award in Interactive Media could progress to a Level 3 qualification or an A Level such as:

- NCFE Level 3 Applied General Certificate in Art and Design (601/8898/4)
- NCFE Level 3 Certificate in Creative Craft (603/3253/0)
- Other level 3 qualifications (including A Levels in creative and media related subjects).
