Level 2 Diploma in Health and Social Care (QRN: 603/4401/5)

(Adults) (Northern Ireland)

This qualification supports learners to develop the knowledge and skills required to work in a range of health and social care settings within Northern Ireland.

Minimum entry age: 16	Credit value: 46
Guided learning hours: 360	Total qualification time: 460

Level 3 Diploma in Health and Social Care (QRN: 603/4724/7) (Adults) (Northern Ireland)

This qualification supports learners to develop the knowledge and skills required to work in a range of health and social care settings within Northern Ireland.

Minimum entry age: 16	Credit value: 58
Guided learning hours: 374	Total qualification time: 580

Level 3 Extended Diploma in Health and Social Care (QRN: 603/5355/7)

(Adults) (Northern Ireland)

This qualification is designed to provide learners with the knowledge, understanding and skills essential to the health and social care sector within Northern Ireland, and to support progression into Higher Education or the workplace. This qualification carries UCAS tariff points.

Level 5 Leadership for Health and Social Care Services (QRN: 603/6041/0)

(Northern Ireland)

This qualification provides learners with the skills and knowledge needed to manage and lead others in adult health and social care provision in Northern Ireland. There are two pathways within this qualification:

Adult Management - The management pathway is suitable for managers who are looking to progress their career. It is also appropriate for managers who have not yet achieved a qualification at this level.

Adult Residential Management - The adult residential management pathway is aimed at those in similar roles taking the management pathway but the focus is on management and care in residential settings.

(Northern Ireland)

This qualification is designed to build the knowledge and skills needed when working with children and young people from birth to 19 years of age. It covers a diverse range of job roles and occupational areas in children's settings, including early years.

Level 3 Extended Diploma for Children's Care, Learning and Development (QRN: 603/7477/9)

(Northern Ireland)

This qualification is designed to provide learners with underpinning knowledge and skills needed when working with children. It covers a diverse range of job roles and occupational areas in children's settings, including early years. The qualification then builds on this knowledge and provides extended knowledge and skills to further learners understanding and provide a stepping stone into higher education.

Level 5 Diploma in Leadership for Children's Care, Learning and Development (Management) (QRN: 603/6040/9)

(Northern Ireland)

This qualification provides learners with the skills and knowledge needed to manage practice and lead others in children's care, learning and development in Wales and Northern Ireland. It covers a wide range of subjects, including: leading professional practice, health and safety and risk management, safeguarding, and developing professional supervision practice.
