About this qualification

The qualification aims to develop learners' knowledge and awareness of dementia for those working in social care settings. It is aimed at learners in school or college, or those working for local authorities or private commercial homeowners.

Learners will develop an understanding and awareness of the causes and symptoms of dementia, allowing for progression to the Level 3 Diploma in Health and Social Care. It may also allow learners to progress into employment in social care settings.

Learners could progress on to a Level 3 Health and Social Care qualification or register onto the apprenticeship standard Lead Adult Care worker which contains the NCFE CACHE Level 3 Diploma in Adult Care.
