Combined

Although no grades are awarded for combined performance in external assessments, learners are required to achieve a minimum UMS score across both papers in order to achieve the qualification. The minimum UMS scores required to achieve the level 1 and level 2 qualifications are 40 and 120 respectively. The following table shows the percentages of learners achieving these scores across both qualifications.
