About this qualification

This qualification provides the knowledge and skills needed for those who wish to work within a Welsh Medium provision in Wales. It covers the age range from birth to 7 years.

Entry requirements

Learners will need to be at least 16 years of age and working at a leader level within a cylch meithrin. We do not set any other entry requirements but colleges or training providers may have their own guidelines.

Experience in the workplace

Learners will need to be working, volunteering or on a practical placement as they need to show competence in both knowledge and skills.

Qualification structure

To complete the Certificate learners must achieve a total of 23 credits from 8 units in mandatory group A.
