Unit 2 – Creating music	Internally assessed and externally assessed
Unit 3 – Sound recording	Internally assessed and externally assessed
Unit 4 – Sound Creation	Internally assessed and externally assessed

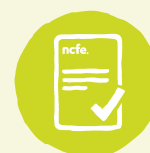
