The NCFE Level 1 and Level 2 Certificates in Craft are aimed at 14 – 16 year olds studying the Key Stage 4 curriculum who are interested in any aspect of craft, including researching ideas and working with different tools and materials. They're an alternative to a GCSE and offer equivalent levels of rigour and challenge.

Qualification structure and how to achieve

To be awarded the NCFE Level 1 or Level 2 Certificates in Craft, pupils are required to successfully complete four mandatory units for each qualification. Pupils must also achieve a minimum of a 'Pass' in the external assessment at level 2.
