This is a joint L1 and L2 external assessment and learners may access grades and UMS across the L1 to L2 range.

Distinction* awarded for overall qualification when:

Dropdown

If a learner is registered on the level 2 qualification and the level 2 pass criteria have not been achieved, the learner can be transferred to the level 1 qualification. If learners are transferred, all external assessment grades will be retained and any internal units banked at level 2 pass or above can be resubmitted for the equivalent units on the level 1 qualification without the need for further assessment or EQA.
